

THREE POINT PROGRAM FOR UNIONS
TO AID FARM WORKERS UNION
AND THE BOYCOTT

I. EDUCATION

- a. Arranging for UFW representatives to meet with local membership (stewards & membership meetings, retiree groups, women's auxiliary, executive board, district council, etc.)
- b. Leafleting of membership by stewards or UFW staff.
- c. Keeping farm worker information posted on bulletin boards, on job sites and in the union hall.

II. PARTICIPATION

- a. Set up a UFW Boycott Committee in the local to help with education, fund-raising, and membership participation.
- b. Pledge one day a month to help with local farm worker picketing or leafleting.
- c. Participate with Cesar Chavez in April 1st Farmworker March here in Cincinnati.

III. FUND-RAISING

- a. Bolster UFW Strike Fund by pledging a monthly donation (\$25-\$100), authorized by the Executive Board or delegate labor body, to run through the grape strike, August 1974.
- b. Hold gate or plant collections preceded by leafleting.
- c. Sell boycott buttons, bumper stickers and the UFW national newspaper, El Malcriado, to members.
