In endorsing the boycott of Gallo wine, Bishop Unteroefler of Charleston said: "Our Eucharistic celebrations use wine in the most powerful and symbolic of ways -- to become the body and blood of our Lord. Use of California wine which came from oppressed labor would be a most ironic and mocking denial of our support for the farmworkers, an example where our actions contradict our words." 6/6/74
