
Grape Strike Is Backed

The New York Civil Liberties Union called on its members yesterday to support the California grape workers' strike by refusing to buy grapes from that state. In what the union called its first appeal to support a boycott of any kind, the civil liberties group also called on stores and markets to support the strike of the United Farm Workers, led by Cesar Chavez.
